

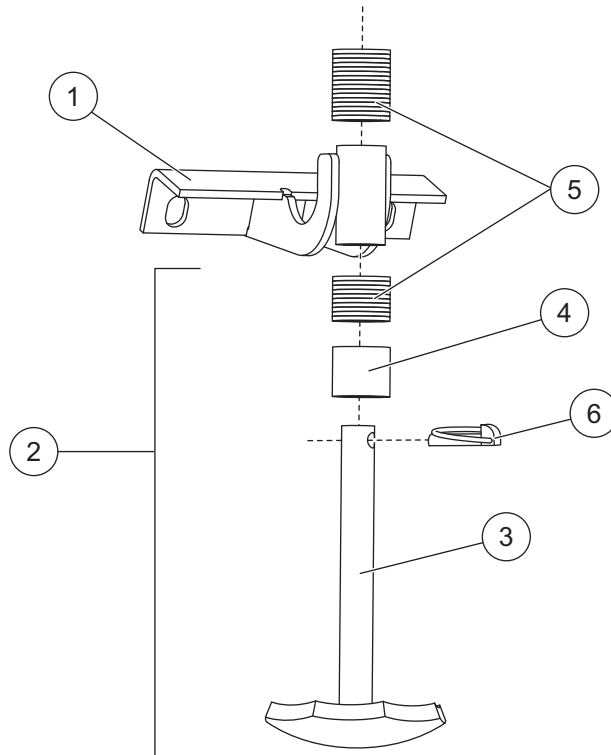

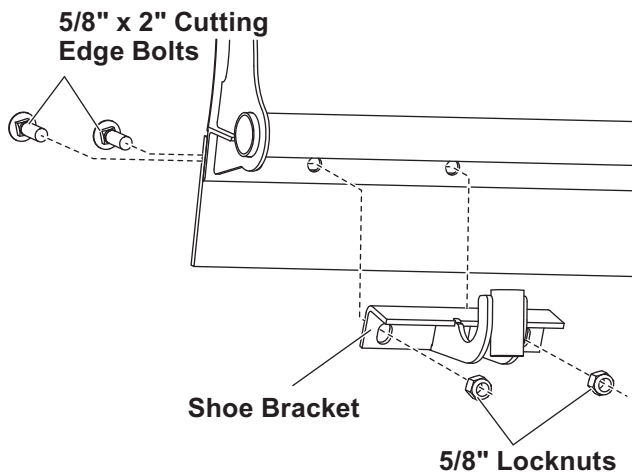
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

⚠ WARNING

Raise and securely support blade with blocks or tip blade face down for installation

NOTE: Please give these instructions to the customer.

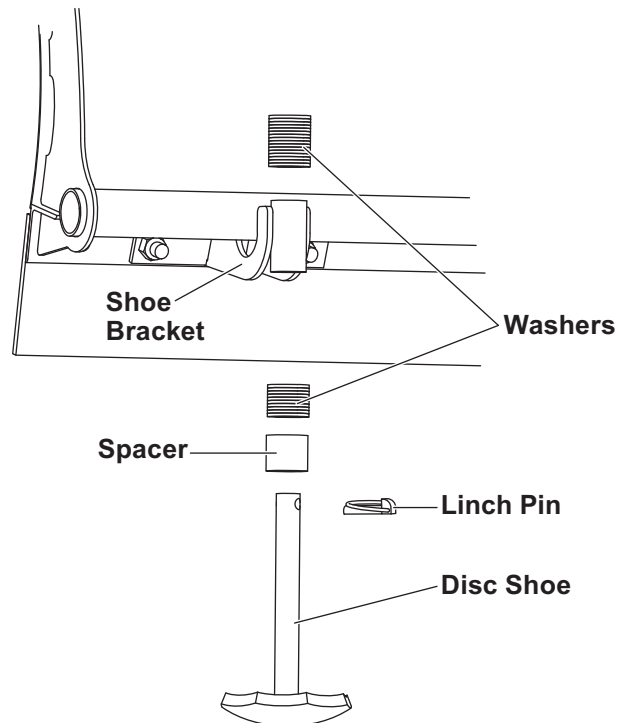
1. Park the vehicle on a smooth, level, hard surface, such as concrete. Disconnect the snowplow from the vehicle, or turn the vehicle ignition to the "OFF" position and remove the key.
2. Position the shoe bracket to the blade base angle as shown below. Align the holes in the shoe bracket with the cutting edge holes in the base angle.
3. Loosely assemble each shoe bracket with two 5/8-11 x 2 cutting edge bolts and 5/8 locknuts through the cutting edge, base angle and shoe bracket. Torque fasteners to 75 ft-lb.



DISC SHOE ALIGNMENT

Changing the number of washers above or below the shoe bracket adjusts the cutting edge height and pressure.

Adjust the disc shoes by placing a spacer and 10 washers on the bottom of the shoe bracket and 16 washers on the top. Final adjustment is made with the snowplow attached to the vehicle. (See below).



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
