




Use standard methods and practices when attaching snowplow and installing accessories, including proper personal protective safety equipment.

See your WESTERN® outlet/website for specific vehicle application recommendations before installation. The Quick Match selection system has specific vehicle and snowplow requirements.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Park the vehicle on a smooth, level, hard surface, such as concrete. Raise the blade, and turn the control to the "OFF" position. From the side of the blade assembly, place a jack stand or sturdy blocking under the guadrant.
- Turn the control to the "ON" position and lower the blade onto the jack stands or blocking. Turn the control OFF and vehicle ignition to the "OFF" position.
- Remove and discard the original carriage bolts and locknuts that secure the cutting edge to the driver-side wing. Remove the urethane cutting edge.
- 4. Position the steel cutting edge and edge retainer plate in front of the blade as shown. Secure both the cutting edge and edge retainer plate to the blade with the carriage bolts and locknuts from the bolt bag.
- 5. Torque fasteners to 115 ft-lb.



- 6. Repeat Steps 3-5 on the passenger's side.
- 7. Turn the vehicle ignition and the control to the "ON" position. Raise the blade slightly from the jack stands. Turn the control to the "OFF" position and remove the jack stands.
- 8. Stand 8' clear of the blade and lower the blade to the ground.
