## HOLD DOWN KIT INSTRUCTIONS

## INSTALLATION

This kit provides an aid for retaining the hopper spreader in the bed of a truck. Refer to the Regular and High Capacity Hopper Spreaders Installation Instructions for primary installation of the hopper spreader.


1. Remove one hook from each turn buckle assembly, thread one 3/8-16 nut onto each hook, replace the hook to the turnbuckle assembly.

Turnbuckle Assembly 3/8-16 Nut

- 2. Attach the chain to the hold down eyelet of the hopper spreader with the link provided.
- 3. The hook placement will vary from truck to truck. If factory tie down eyelets are not available, eye bolts (not provided) must be installed.
- 4. Hook one end of the turnbuckle to the factory tie down or the eye bolt. Pull the chain tight and hook the other end of the turnbuckle to the chain.
- 5. Turn the center section of the turnbuckle to tension the chain. Tighten the 3/8 nut to lock the hooks in place.

## **A**CAUTION

Turnbuckles may loosen during use. Check the tension of the chain before each use of the spreader and after 25 miles.
